auDA is the not-for-profit industry self regulatory body responsible for the oversight and operation of the .au domain name space.

Paul co-ordinates auDA's promotional, community-engagement and awareness-raising initiatives. These include auDA-driven projects such as the Australia and New Zealand Internet Best Practice Awards and collaboration with industry and government on efforts such as National e-Security Week and National Consumer Fraud Week. He develops auDA position statements on national and international policy matters for fora such as the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN) and the UN's Internet Governance Forum (IGF). Based in Canberra, Paul is also auDA's primary governmental liaison.

Prior to joining auDA, Paul worked as a Senior Policy Officer at the Australian Department of Broadband, Communications and the Digital Economy. In this role, Paul's main focus was on the government oversight of Australia's .au domain space, including acting as the Governmental Observer on the auDA Board between 2003 and 2008 and undertaking a government review of .au arrangements in 2006.

Between 2001 and 2003, Paul fulfilled the Secretariat role for the Governmental Advisory Committee of ICANN and acted as Australia's GAC Representative and Advisor to the Australian
