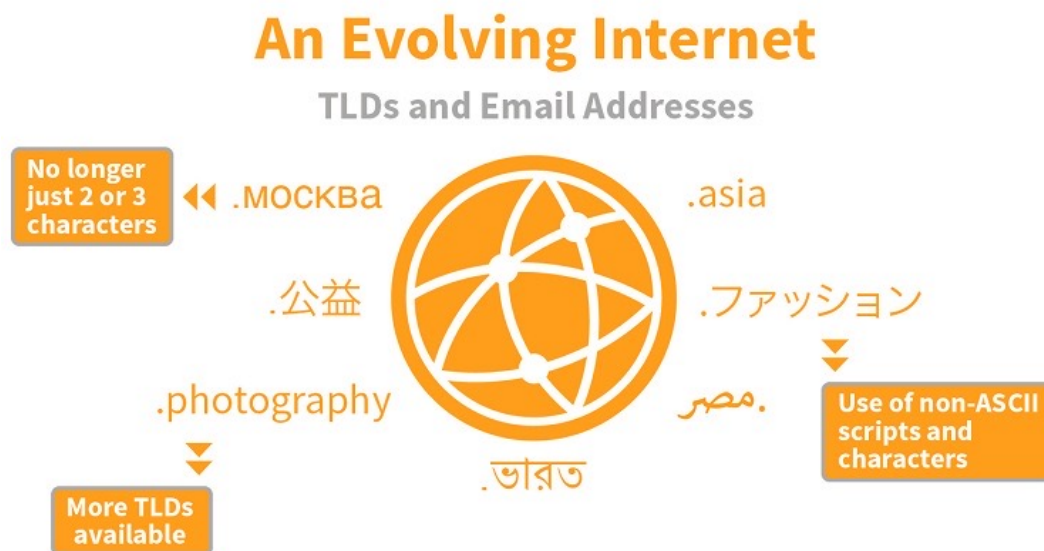

APAC DNS Forum 2023

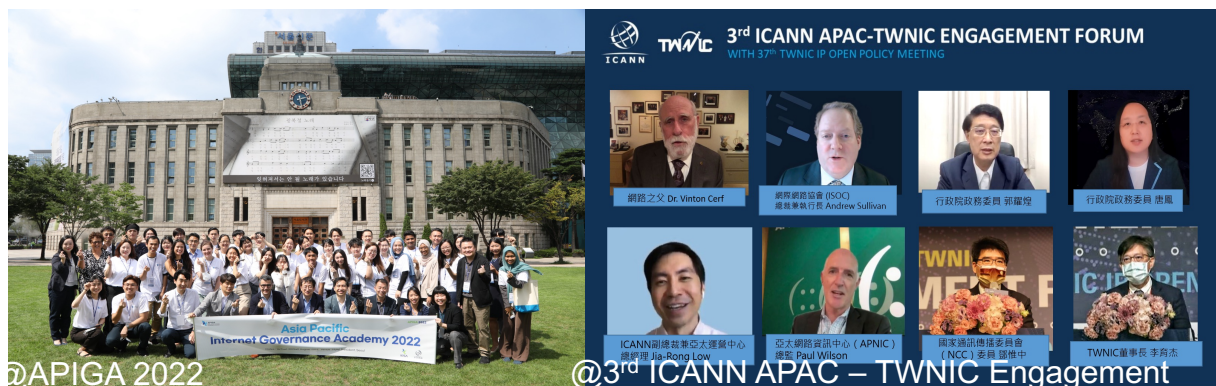

Call for Trusted Community Representatives (TCRs)

Trusted Community Representatives

- ⦿ TCRs colloquially known as Internet “keyholders”
- ⦿ Volunteers oversee how ICANN and IANA keep the cryptographic keys to the Internet safe.
- ⦿ TCRs are expected to be trusted by the community, and convey confidence in our operations through their oversight.
- ⦿ They are expected to report back to their communities on how the key ceremony was performed, as well as provide suggestions on improving operations.
- ⦿ We select TCRs to be a mix of relevant backgrounds and experiences; Asia Pacific is currently under-represented
