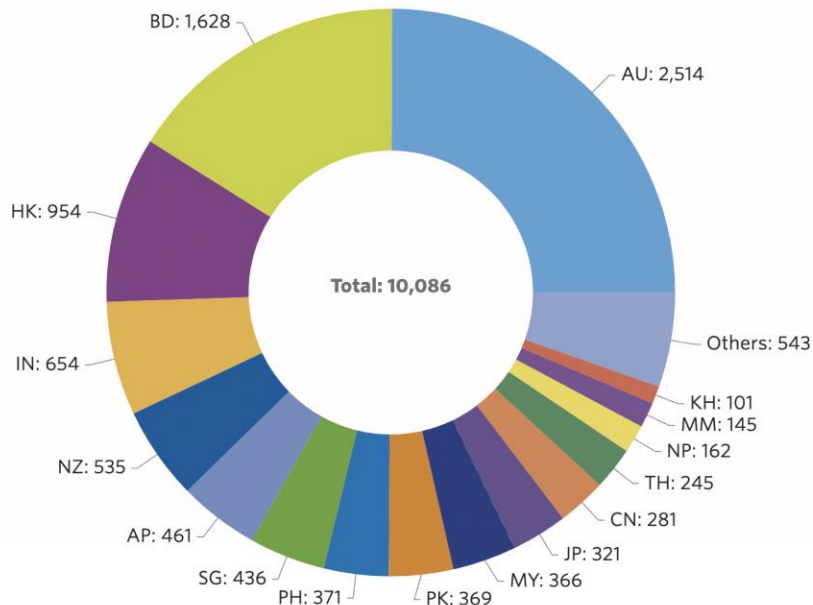

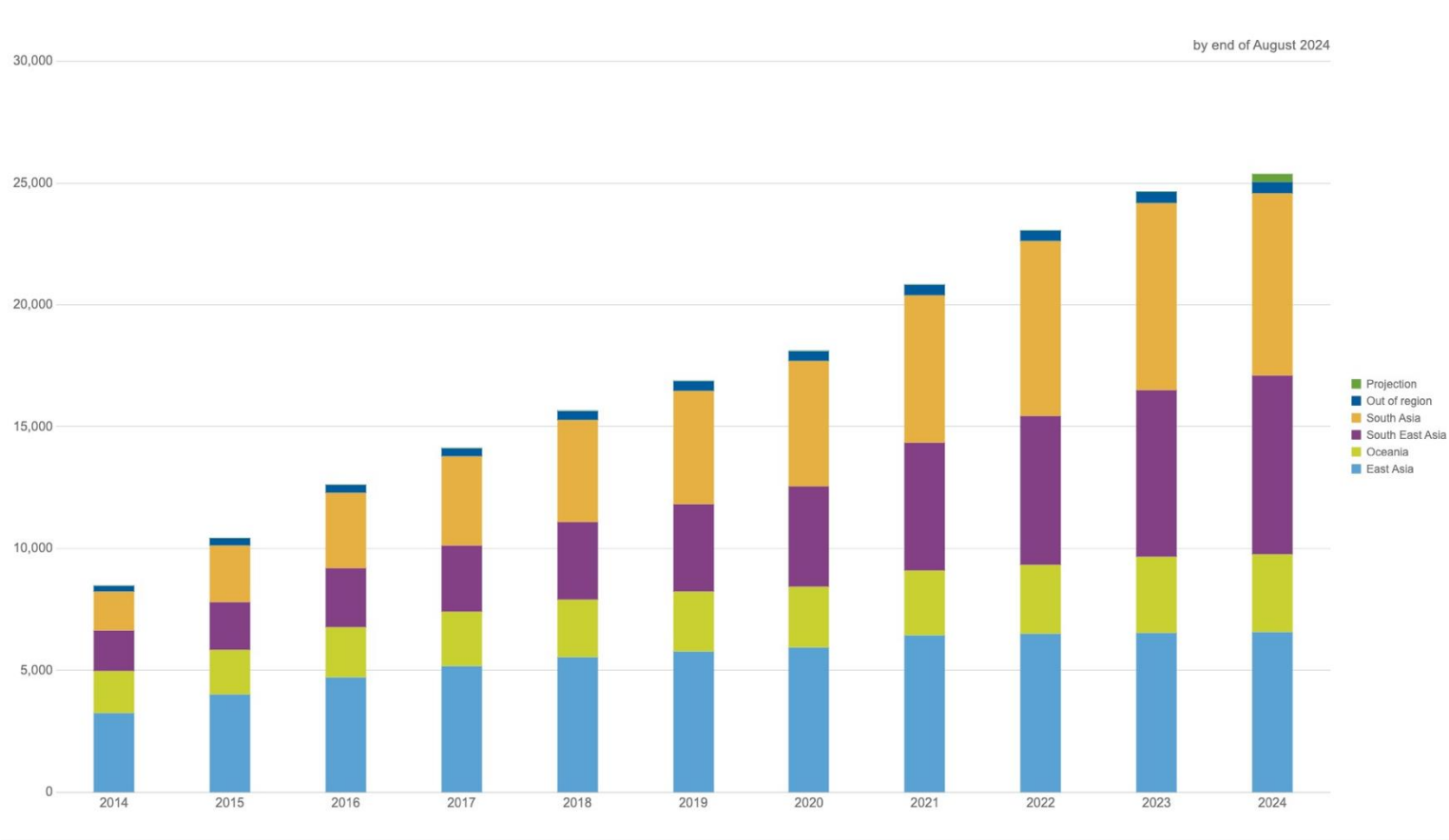
APNIC Membership

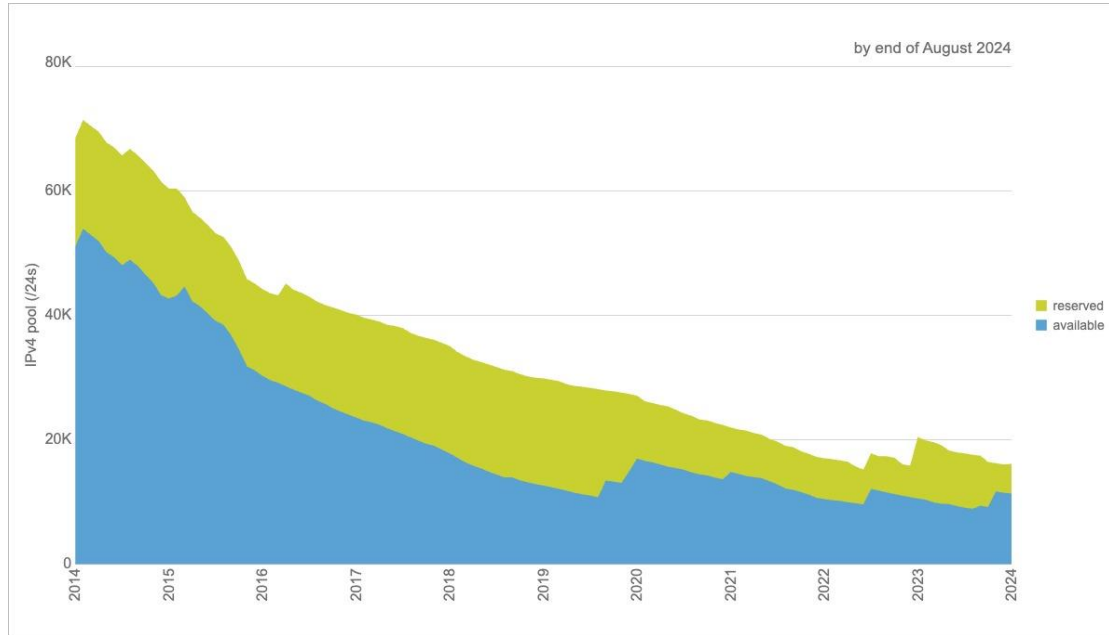

- APNIC has exhausted fresh 103 prefixes from final /8 block.
- New addresses delegated are from recycled pool.



Internet Development – Training and Infrastructure Support

- 104 instructor-led training courses
 - Training at 9 NOGs, 4 NIRs
 - Partnered with Asi@Connect for 10 events
 - New Network Automation workshop along with ‘Train-the-Trainer’ at APRICOT 2024
 - Training with KDDI and APT in Laos, Myanmar (online) and Indonesia
- 20 online open tutorials
- 33 Volunteer and 10 Retained CTs
- Training, deployment support and advice provided to seven IXPs
- Five M-Root deployments completed
- 19 instances of TA to Members on IPv6, RPKI, routing and BGP
- 33 Volunteer and 10 Retained CTs
