Highlights (1/2):

- For use of DNS, themes of best practice **sharing and standardisation of security measures** was popular, as well as **promoting IDNs**.
- For building capacity of interested parties, themes of working closely with **government** and working with **youth** and promoting public awareness were raised. Also, improving access by providing information in own **languages**. Developing **tools** to collaborate was raised.

Highlights (2/2):

- On promoting integrity and standards, people raised joining forces to combat DNS abuse, raising awareness of DNSSEC, and standing up volunteer groups to promote these goals.
- On achieving goals of **multi-stakeholder system** (working with other I* organisations):
 - Devolve power to grassroots communities.
 - Continue supporting each other as cctlds.
