1. Capacity Building effort for AP youth : APIGA



About APIGA

- The Asia Pacific Internet Governance Academy(APIGA) is a capacity development program focused on Internet Governance, targeted at APAC youths(aged 18-35)
- Started in 2016 as a cooperation project between KISA and ICANN
- The program aims to develop youth leaders' understand of the Internet and its ecosystem, and to encourage ongoing participation in the IG ecosystem
- Key highlights for APIGA : (1) a strong focus on immersive, hand-on learning, (2) networking opportunities with regional community leaders and peers

About APIGA

- 2016~2024 : 384 participants from average 16 countries
- 1 in 4 APIGA alumni continue to participate in Internet governance fora locally, regionally, and globally.

Expanding APIGA

- Conduct ‘**Local hubs**’ under the branding of APIGA
- Local APIGA Structure
 - Local participants, local APIGA alumni, local speakers and mentors
 - Conducted mostly in local language

➤ **Key Benefits for Local APIGA**

- Grow local youth leaders
- Remove language barrier
- Facilitate local talent retention through stronger local network
- Lower costs, simpler logistics requirements, less staff resource needed to organize the event
- Selected top participants are directly eligible for regional APIGA in Korea

- Recent 10 years of history between KISA and VNNIC
 - New MoU in every 3+1 years(2015, 2019, 2023)
 - Regular bilateral meeting(target Once a year)
- **KISA-VNNIC MoU** : Sharing strategy, policy, technology, experience in below area
 1. Development and Promotion of ccTLD
 2. IP address and AS number management
 3. DNS Operation and Internet Security
 4. Internet related statistics, DNS query monitoring, other related technologies
 5. New internet standards, networking technologies and any other technical criteria
 6. Capacity building for IT specialist
